



PM&E The Municipality of Anchorage is planning to upgrade Duben Avenue to improve vehicular and pedestrian safety in the neighborhood. The corridor has been divided into two separate projects:

- 1) Duben Avenue West (Patterson Street to Muldoon Road); and
- 2) Duben Avenue East (Muldoon Road to Bolin Street).

Upgrades along both sections will include better drainage, improved sight distances at intersections and steep hills, a new sidewalk and/or pathway to separate pedestrians from traffic, and improved street lighting for better visibility. Each project received a 2012 State grant for \$3 million dollars; additional funding will be necessary to construct the projects.

The design team is just beginning to gather data along the corridor. This spring, survey crews will be mapping the right-of-way boundaries, driveways, utility locations, and building corners. Geotechnical crews will also be drilling within the publically-owned right-of-way to collect soil and groundwater information.

Thank you in advance for your patience and please use caution when driving near the survey and geotechnical crews.

Planning and design will take place over the next two years. The earliest construction could occur is 2015 (pending funding availability).
