



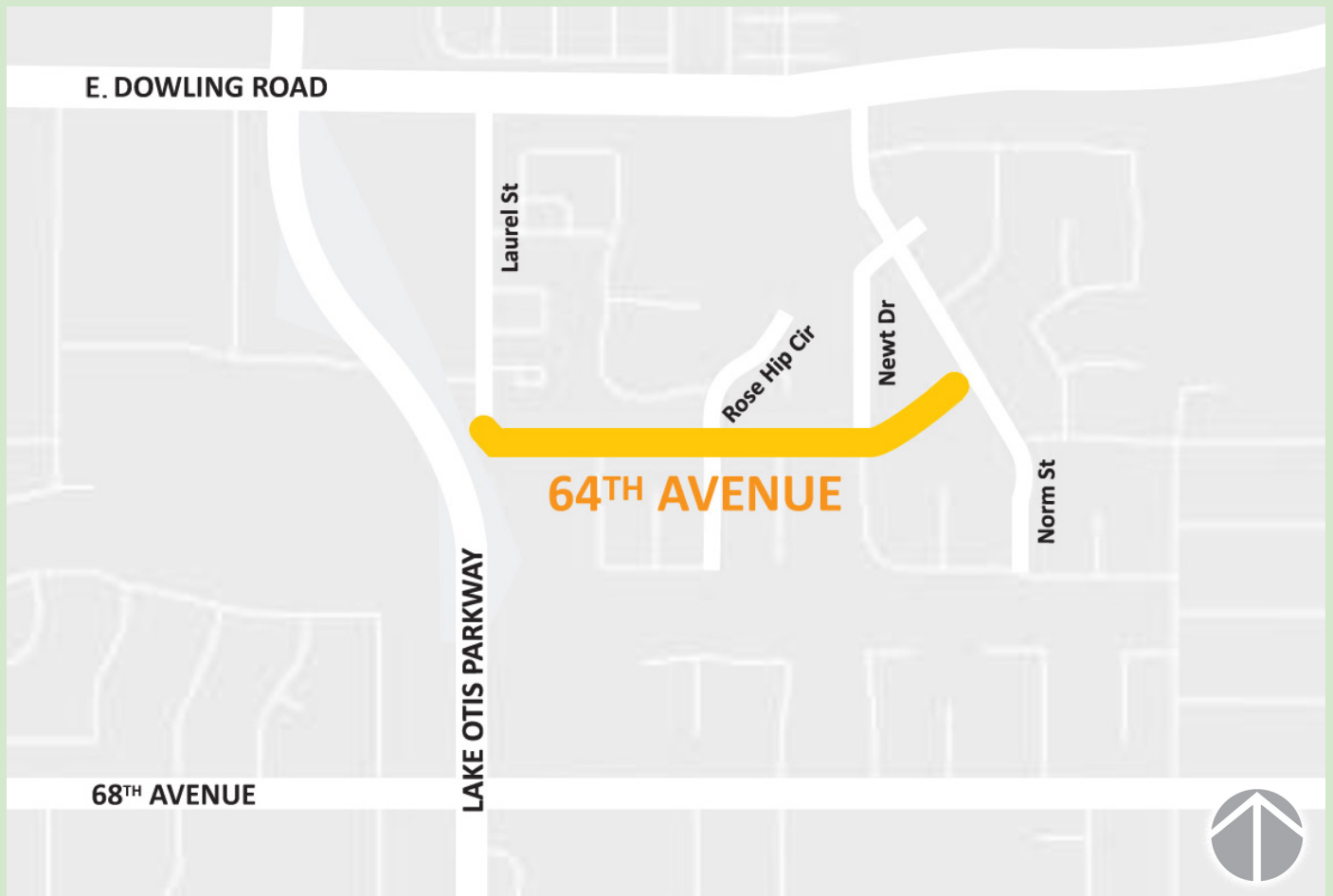
64th Avenue Upgrade & Reconstruction

Laurel to Norm

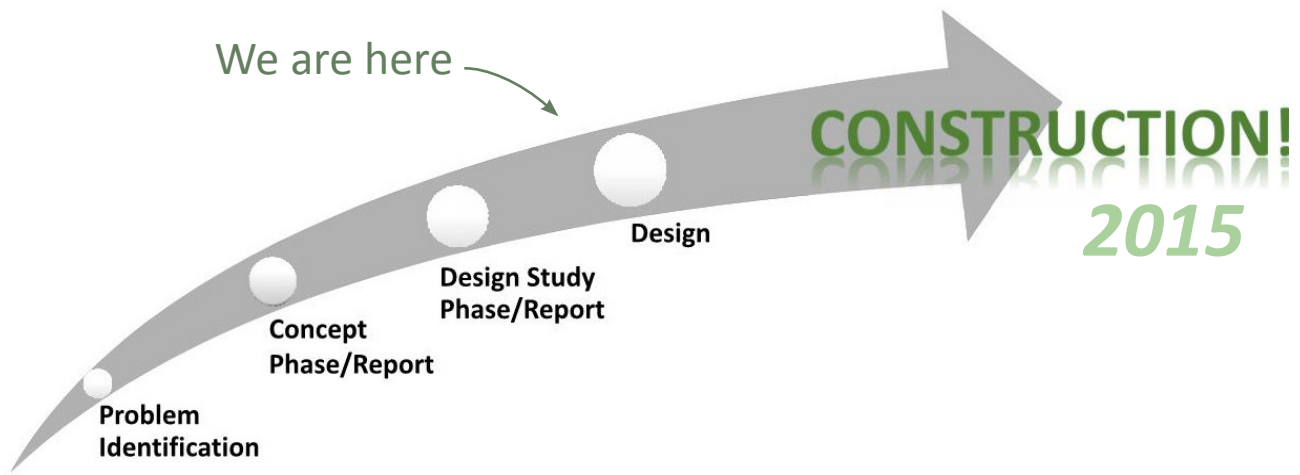
PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Municipality of Anchorage (MOA) will be reconstructing 64th Avenue from Laurel Street to Norm Drive to meet current Municipality of Anchorage standards. This will include upgrading the roadway, drainage, and lighting, and adding sidewalks on both sides of the roadway. The project also includes widening the road at the Laurel Street and 64th Avenue curve and upgrading the existing sedimentation basin.

Project Status

Design. The project is currently in the preliminary design phase. Next steps will be pre-final and final designs, which will be reviewed by MOA before approval. The final design is anticipated to be complete by the spring of 2015.

Project Funding. Project design and construction is fully funded through state grants.

Right-of-Way Acquisition. ROW acquisition is expected to begin in late 2014.

Construction. Construction will begin during the summer of 2015.
